Happy Halloween Safety Reminder

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

With Halloween just around the corner, we wanted to ask for your help to make Thursday, October 31st safe and fun at school. On Halloween, many of our students would like to come to school wearing a costume. Some prefer to wear orange and black, while others prefer not to participate, which is fine too. We would ask, however, that if your child is wearing a costume that either they wear it over their clothes in the morning or can easily put it on themselves as the staff will not have time to dress all the students in their classes. Students will be asked to take off their costumes before they go outside for recess so that they will, hopefully, not get damaged before Halloween.

In addition, we respectfully ask that replica weapons (like knives, guns and swords) **not be brought to school** for safety reasons. Similarly, masks should not be worn except for the morning (first 100 minute block) when the students can show their costume at our Character Education assembly. It is also important to remember that some of our students are as young as 3 years old so we discourage costumes that are overly frightening.

For the safety of our students, if you are sending a treat for your child's class, please make sure that it is nut free. Thank you and Happy Halloween!
