This committee will include the following representatives from each affected school: the principal, as well as a student, parent and staff representative from each school in the Crestwood Family of Schools.

The Transition Committee will begin meeting later this month. The ideas generated here will help in planning effective student, family and staff activities such as evening open houses, athletics, extracurricular opportunities, transportation, school schedule and more. Each school's parent/guardian representative will be chosen with the involvement of its School Council. If you would like to put your name forward to North Cavan School Council to sit on the Transition Committee, please contact me as soon as possible.

As always, if you have specific concerns regarding how your child will be affected by the transition, please speak with the teacher or with me. We are here to support your child.
