attendance. If there is a student absent without a message we will phone home.

*Notes: you can write notes regarding upcoming absences (appointments, holidays) in your child's agenda. The teacher will relay this information to the office.

Fire Drill & Lock Down Drill:

In order to be prepared for emergencies at North Cavan the students and staff will take part in 6 fire drills and 2 lock down drills over the school year.

Criminal Record Checks

As per KPR policy all volunteers must have a current criminal record check on file at the school before working with any students. This includes School Council, Breakfast Club and all school trips. I would strongly recommend that parents have a criminal record check completed in September so you are covered for the year. If you wait until just before a trip/event it likely won't be back in time.

You need to pick up a 'Vulnerable Sector Search' letter from the school office then take this to the Peterborough City Police Department on Water Street with 2 forms of identification. These can be any form of government issued ID. (driver's license, Health Card, passport, Birth certificate)

Pupil Information forms: (Student verification)

These forms went home on Tuesday with all students. Please complete and or check all of the pages of the Student Verification forms. This information is entered into our student data base and it's vital that it be accurate. If something changes through the year please let the office know. Please return the forms as soon as possible.

Twitter there's a new box to check off in this information package it's the TWITTER box. North Cavan is on twitter. We will post Tweets over the course of the year to share some of the cool, interesting and exciting things that are happening in our building. We will only post photos of students that have parent's permission. To view twitter posts you can follow North Cavan or log onto the North Cavan website.

Grade 1 – 6 students have each received a North Cavan student Agenda at a cost of \$5.00 each. The agenda is an excellent way to improve organization skills and time management. It is also an easy way to maintain communication between the

home and school. Please take the time to review the school information at the front of the agenda and review it with your children regularly.

Cell Phones at School:

There should not be any need for students to have cell phones at school. However if they require one for after school, the phone should stay in the nap sack out of sight for the entire day including the bus trip. Mobile devices can only be used in class with the teacher's permission. Contact with home should be done using the office phone.

Technology at School:

Students should not be bringing ipods or gaming devices to use at school UNLESS their teacher has requested or approved it being at school. Music devices on the bus with 'ear buds' are acceptable to make the trip easier.

Dress Code:

Please remember that clothing at school should be modest and comfortable. All clothing should cover the torso from the shoulders to the mid-thigh. Shoulder straps should be 2 fingers wide and shorts need to be mid-thigh length.

School Picture Day:

Edge Imaging Photography will be at North Cavan on Monday, September 12th to take individual and class photos. All photos will be done in the morning starting with the youngest children. If your child is sick that day you may bring them in for their picture then take them home. There will also be a re-take day on Tuesday, October 25th. Grade 6 grad photos will be taken in the spring.

Indoor shoes: (no crocs as indoor shoes please)

All students are required to have indoor shoes for in school travel and for Phys. Ed. classes.

Some of the fall team practices and events will take place outside. The students will be allowed to use their indoor gym shoes for these outdoor school related activities if they do not own a pair of appropriate gym shoes for outside.

School Bus:

All of the North Cavan students ride a bus to and from school on a total of 4 busses. The busses usually leave the school at 3:40pm. If for any reason they are late leaving we will try to contact you by phone to let you know. If your child is late arriving home please call the school and we will try to help solve the problem. All students are expected to remain seated on the bus, use an inside voice, no eating or drinking and follow the driver's instructions. If your child misbehaves on the bus they could receive a bus report. Depending upon the severity or the frequency, your child could lose their bus privileges. The student's receive bus safety training twice each year.


