Safe School Initiatives:

All parents are asked to please check in at the office when you visit the school. If you are picking your child up early please come into the school and sign them out at the office. If your child is being picked up at the end of the day instead of riding the bus, please come in to get them and let the office know. For safety reasons, we don't wish to have children walking through the parking lot.

- *Absent Child: please phone the school (705-944-5366) ext. 40 every day that your child is absent. Please state your child's name, teacher and the reason for the absence. Messages are checked against attendance. If there is a student absent without a message we will phone home.
- *Notes: you can write notes regarding upcoming absences (appointments, holidays) in your child's agenda. The teacher will relay this information to the office.

Contact Numbers: If your contact number has changed please let Ms. Nolan know at the office so that we have the most up to date information.



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Criminal Record Checks

As per KPR policy all volunteers must have a current criminal record check on file at the school before working with any students. This includes School Council, Breakfast Club and all school trips. You can pick up the necessary paper work from the office then take it to the Peterborough Police Headquarters on Water St. The charge for a police check is \$11.30. It usually takes approximately 2 weeks to complete.

Cell Phones at School:

There should not be any need for students to have cell phones while at school. However if they require one for after school the phone should stay in the nap sack out of sight for the entire day including on bus trips.



Technology at school:

Students should not be bringing ipods or gaming devices to use at school UNLESS their teacher has requested or approved of it being at school. Music devices on the bus with 'ear buds' are acceptable to make the trip easier. The school provides ipads and computers when students need them for their learning at school.

Breakfast Club News:

We've had a great start with the Breakfast Club program, the students were certainly glad to see the breakfast volunteers back! Thank you so much to all the returning & brand



new volunteers. We couldn't run the program five days a week without you!

Every child at North Cavan is able to start their day off with a snack in their class which includes at least 3 of the 4 food groups. For example, they can eat crackers, celery sticks, apple slices and cheese cubes. This is a typical daily "menu". We encourage you to ask your child what they had for breakfast club. Studies show

that when children attend school well-nourished it improves their ability to learn which gives them the best chance to be successful. By the time many of your children reach their desk and are expected to focus on their studies, it has been a while since they've eaten, and this snack provides them with the nutrition they need to perform well in class.

There are certainly ways in which you can help out without volunteering your time. We accept food donations (i.e. Bag of apples, block of cheese, tub of cream cheese etc.), grocery gift cards, or a financial donation can be made to the school through pcchu.ca/ffk and a tax receipt will be issued to you.
